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A. CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Board Meeting of the Veranda Community Development District was called to order at 10:30 am at the Veranda Clubhouse at 238 SE Courances Drive, Port St. Lucie, Florida 34984

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

It was determined that the attendance of Chairman David Kanarek, and Supervisors Garrett Dinsmore, and Jermaine Lemon constituted a quorum, and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

3. Consider Resolution No. 2023-03 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Final Budget

RE: Veranda Community Development District Auditor Renewal

At the March 8, 2021 Veranda Community Development District Board Of Supervisors meeting, the firm of Grau & Associates was selected to perform the 9-30-2020, 9-30-2021 and 9-30-2022 year end audits of the District with an option to perform the 9-30-2023 and 9-30-2024 audits.

The fees for the 9-30-2020 audit were \$3,600. The fees for the 9-30-2021 audit were \$3,700. And the fees for the 9-30-2022 audit were \$3,800. The proposed fee for the 9-30-2023 audit is \$3,900, which is the budgeted amount for audit fees for Fiscal Year 2023/2024. And the proposed fee for the 9-30-2024 audit is \$4,000.

Management is pleased with the professionalism and the competence of the Grau & Associates partners and staff; therefore management recommends that the Board approve the renewal option for the Fiscal Year Ending 9-30-2023 and 9-30-2024 audits for Grau & Associates.
